PUBLIC WORKS PROJECT

This notice is to update you on the forthcoming activities at the DPW project at 17147 Maumee Ave. With less traffic on the road, the contractor would like to complete the underground storm system which will be tied into the City system on the opposite side of the existing DPS building from the water main. This means that Maumee, City Hall entrance and parking lot will need to be disrupted. Starting Monday April 20th, Maumee will be shutdown to allow the underground tie in. We expect that work to take 5-7 days. During this time, the sidewalks will remain open to pedestrians. City Hall will be placing a drop box at the corner of Neff and Maumee for any drops that need to be made during this shutdown time. The pre-engineered building is complete at this time, and the work continues on the conventionally framed materials and salt storage building, to get that portion closed in. Interior underground is wrapping up and the floor will be poured in the upcoming weeks. The City of Grosse Pointe wishes to apologize in advance for any inconvenience related to the construction and hopes to complete the project in a timely manner.
