### **NOTICE TO RESIDENTS**

### **PUBLIC WORKS PROJECT**

This notice is to update you on the forthcoming activities at the DPW project at 17147 Maumee Ave. The concrete contractor is working to complete the onsite parking lot concrete paving and pour the drives. The City Hall entrance and parking lot are blocked off until the concrete is cured and ready to accept limited traffic. Maumee is partially obstructed to allow the concrete contractor to place the new paving on the site and drive approach including work on Saturday, June 6. We expect that work and the cure time to take 7-10 days. During this time, the sidewalks will remain closed to through pedestrian traffic. The City Hall drop box at the corner of Neff and Maumee will remain open and accessible for any drops that need to be made during this shutdown time. Work continues on the conventionally framed materials and salt storage building, to get that portion closed in. Interior electrical service installation, fire protection sprinkler systems, and interior space build out continue.
