### **TEMPORARY RELOCATION**

As you may be aware the City is replacing its existing Public Works building on Maumee with a new, fully contained facility. During the course of construction, the Public Works department staff, material, equipment and vehicles will need to be relocated. For about the next year, the Public Services Department will operate from the Pump Station at the corner of Charlevoix and Neff as well as store vehicles and materials in the back areas of the parking lot behind CVS (Lot 4).

The Department of Public Services is preparing to exit out the current Public Works building on Maumee to allow for the demolition and construction of a new Public Works facility in its place. This means that most of the equipment and vehicles will be stored and operated out of the fenced in area in Lot 4, (the area by the cell tower). The current fence line in Lot 4 will be extended out to accommodate this temporary move. Over the next week you will start to see trucks and equipment starting to use the area. Public Works employees will park there in the morning and leave after work. To make room for Public Works, Beaumont Hospital staff and shuttle will no longer use this area for off-site parking. When the new, larger Public Works facility is finished all of the Public Works staff, materials and equipment will be completely removed from the cell tower and Lot 4 area.

The City apologizes, in advance for the inconveniences and disruptions that this will temporary relocation will cause.
